1 Corinthians Chapter 10

1 Corinthians 10:13

Theology

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

1 Corinthians 10:23-27

Evangelism

All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful; all things are lawful for me, but not all things edify. 24 Let no one seek his own, but each one the other's well-being.

**25 Eat whatever is sold in the meat market,
asking no questions for conscience'
sake; 26 for "the earth is the Lord's, and all
its fullness." 27 If any of those who do not
believe invites you to dinner, and you desire
to go, eat whatever is set before you asking
no question for conscience sake.**
